Statement - Flight Centre Litigation

Dublin, 13 December 2011

Datalex today announces that it has successfully settled its legal case with Flight Centre of Australia.

Datalex and Flight Centre have negotiated in good faith and resolved the proceedings to their mutual satisfaction.

The settlement, which will complete in 2012, will result in a Balance Sheet adjustment of approximately \$2m as an exceptional item in 2011, against receivables and unrecovered expenditures.

The guided operating performance for EBITDA and year-end cash for 2011 is unaffected.

Datalex is happy to conclude these proceedings. This will enable us to focus in 2012 on our strong business pipeline, and deliver further cash and EBITDA growth on that already achieved in 2010 and projected for 2011.
